In addition, from this software you can carry out the final evaluation and obtain ECVET credits so that they can later be validated from the VET center.

Through the “Collaborative work” section you can communicate both with your tutors (the company and the educational center) and with other students who they are carrying out mobilities. Through these tools, you will not only exchange ideas and good practices, you will also collaborate with your colleagues, generating bonds of solidarity and feeling accompanied at all times.



## WRITE THE LAB NOTEBOOK

From the “Lab notebook” section you must complete this working document, creating a daily report with a structure that allows you to develop critical and scientific thinking skills. In addition, after completing each diary, your tutors will be able to make comments and suggestions that will help you better understand your results and progressively progress in the development of the assigned tasks. The laboratory notebook is a useful and effective learning tool that allows you to develop the necessary skills to face the job market.

## ACCESS TO TRAINING RESOURCES

From the “training resources” section you have access to relevant information about the job that you are going to do during the internship, the company where you are going to do it, the characteristics of the mobility and the tutor you are going to. to have in the company.

Also, you can directly access the Course “Personalized digital Course for labor training in technological centers” that will allow you to acquire skills and abilities necessary for the development of work in a technology company.

Likewise, you have access to specific glossaries of the technical field in which you are going to carry out the internship. These glossaries contain hundreds of explanations of relevant concepts related to the work you are going to do.

# ARE YOU A TUTOR FROM A TECHNOLOGY COMPANY THAT IS GOING TO RECEIVE VET STUDENTS?

## CARRY OUT THE MONITORING AND THE EVALUATION REPORTS AUTOMATICALLY



From the “Evaluation and Follow-Up” section you can access all the daily entries in the lab notebook that the students have made and add notes about the work they have done. This allows you to carry out a daily control of the work they are doing in the company, as well as provide information and suggestions that they may need to understand the task they are doing. In addition, you can carry out the final evaluation. Once you have completed the final evaluation document, it will be sent to the tutor of the VET center so that he/she can complete his/her final evaluation and accredit the ECVET credits that the student has obtained.

## **CARRY OUT THE MONITORING AND THE EVALUATION REPORTS AUTOMATICALLY**

From the “Evaluation and Follow-Up” section you can access all the daily entries of the laboratory notebook that the students have made to get a closer look at the work they are doing. You can also add notes on the work they have done in order to improve their learning. From the same section where you monitor your students you can carry out the final evaluation, which allows you to access the download of all the documents necessary to carry out the subsequent validation of ECVET credits. Once the tutor of the technology company has filled out the final evaluation document, you can open and read it, as well as add your evaluation in a specific document. Once all the documentation has been completed, a final evaluation report in pdf will be generated that you will receive by email.



## **COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR STUDENTS AND THE OTHER TUTOR**

You can communicate with your students and their tutor from the technology company at all times, which allows you not only to solve questions for your students but also to maintain fluid communication with their tutor from the technology company. This section have specific resources to favor the participation of students in European mobility stating the benefits of this type of international internship and providing the information and access to them.

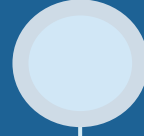
## SERVICES FOR THE SOCIAL INTEGRATION OF STUDENTS IN EUROPE

This software contain dynamic resources for communication not only between the tutor of the VET center, but also with the person responsible for the student in the workplace and with the students of the program who are doing mobility in other technology centers . This allow to promote the exchange of good practices and a collaborative methodology among the participants so that they help each other, generate bonds of solidarity and feel accompanied.
